You'll spend days exploring our famous Antique Alley. A destination unto itself, this trail rambles through

historic and scenic towns with a variety of small and large antique shops and malls, offering more than 1,000 antique dealers along two loop trails. More great shopping awaits you at numerous specialty gift shops.

Foodies will love our culinary scene - from quaint coffee shops in historically preserved buildings, to acclaimed fine dining in a grand old home. There's renowned BBQ in a pre-Civil War firehouse, and a homemade ice cream parlor that was featured on national television. From international flavors to Indiana's oldest continuously running tavern, it's easy to eat and drink your way through Wayne County.

There's an environmental passion in Wayne County, and you'll see it just

about everywhere you look. In fact, the sustainable Cope Environmental Center was built to meet the "Living Building Challenge," a certification program so stringent in its requirements that only a few buildings around the world have qualified for the highest level. Our 466-acre arboretum has ponds, fields, and wetlands with 16 miles of hiking and mountain biking trails and educational opportunities - all free to the public. A big part of the Cardinal Greenway, Indiana's longest rail-to-trail covering 62 miles, runs through Wayne County and is a big draw for hikers and cyclists.

Antique Alley Trails

Antique Alley is Indiana's most diverse antique shopping destination. The National Road, once the main thoroughfare for horses and wagons and later for cars, connects charming towns such as Richmond, Centerville, and Cambridge City. The trail then branches out onto scenic back roads, forming two loops of seemingly endless antique stores.



2 Chocolate Trail

Feed your chocolate cravings with locally made chocolate

delights. This sweet trail is free and available year-round. With 12+ stops, the self-guided trail leads you to a candy factory, ice cream parlor, bakeries, Amish market, restaurants, and gift shops. The highlight on the trail is Abbott's Candies, which has been making chocolates since the 1890s.



3 Murals Trail

On our Murals Trail, you'll find historic buildings blanketed with over 80

colorful murals created by world-class mural artists. From hidden alleyways to busy streets, Wayne County's murals define and capture the beauty, history, and culture of the community. There is a mural for every artistic preference from the historical to whimsical.



4 Fairy Trail

Fairy dwellings and wings have magically appeared in shops, cafes, museums,

gardens, and galleries throughout
Richmond. These offer a glimpse into the
mystical world of fairies. Built with a colorful
array of materials, these interactive fairy
dwellings offer you an exciting chance to
explore the area in a unique fashion.

Antiques & Shopping

"Perfect," she said to herself, her gasoline sign-crazed son in mind. She snapped a cell phone photo, not quite ready to buy. A couple months went by. She'd looked at that photo dozens of times; finally, she called the antique store. It was still there. Her son found it under his Christmas tree. That's how it goes sometimes along eastern **Indiana's Antique Alley**. More often than not, however, it's an instant purchase. Something the buyer had always wanted - or didn't know he wanted until he saw it.

The antique stores here pair knowledgeable dealers with a passion for their profession. Today's shops are bright, clean and spacious with items displayed in charming vignettes. Some pieces sell for hundreds, even thousands of dollars, others for just a couple bucks.

Beth Leisure, the owner of the **National Road Antique Mall**, has been in Cambridge City for 20 years. "I have something for everyone," she says, because "almost everybody collects something. People coming from near and far don't even believe our prices," Leisure says.

Antique Alley sells to not only individual shoppers but also to dealers, who come with huge trucks and fill them. Doug Price of **High Hats Antique Mall** says dealers call eastern Indiana their "honey pot."

Cambridge City's **Building 125** is actually four separate and spacious buildings open from one to another inside. It's got both antiques and

reproductions in furniture, primitives, and quilts, plus small items that include note cards, linens, jewelry, and candles. "I just want to attract a little bit of everybody," says owner Norma Bertsch.

Wheeler's Antiques in Centerville started the local antique craze in 1970. "My husband and I both liked antiques and the house got too full, so it was time to open shop," says owner Sue Wheeler. She now shares the business with her son, Scott. "We like to find something unusual, something you don't see just everywhere. I tried to pare down, but I love finding and I love buying."

The business has always had two buildings across the street from one another. Sue Wheeler handles the shop with glassware, paintings, and other more delicate items. Bigger items that include toys, signs, and furniture are in the other building, which Scott Wheeler runs. "My dad's theory was that if one side of the street burned down, we'd still open up the next day," he says.

The **Centerville Antique Mall** is the largest facility along Indiana's Antique Alley. It offers merchandise from many vendors ranging from small jewelry pieces to huge tractors.

Just across the state line in quaint New Paris, Ohio, the **New Paris Antique Mall** offers four floors of unique antiques and collectibles, all under one roof.

Yes, antiques are big here. But there's more.

Boutique shopping beckons at **Luxe Lizzies**, a retail space in the Loft in Richmond's Historic Depot District. Luxe Lizzies offers a unique blend of trendy fashion finds and home accents.

Downtown Richmond is home to **Esmond's Shoes**, owned and operated by the same local family since 1950. They pride themselves in not only offering a great variety of quality footwear, but also in providing real, honest in-store service to their customers.



ANTIQUE ALLEY

Antique Alley is a hotbed of vintage finds and is one of Indiana's most diverse antique destinations. Two different trails will guide you to more than 1,000 antique dealers offering a plethora of fun finds. Don't miss historic Cambridge City, the hub of Antique Alley, with more than ten distinctive shops and malls within a two-block area. Plan an overnight stay, because just one day isn't enough to uncover all the hidden treasures.

Besides antiques, Centerville is also home to **The Village Forager**, a bright and cheery shopping venue where you can browse for hip gift items, home décor, and more while sipping on your favorite hot beverage from the coffee bar.

Down the street is **The Bent Nickel**, offering aesthetic appeal, meaningful gifts and home goods.





More than 80 towering illustrations chronicle Wayne County's history, all done as murals and celebrated on the **Murals Trail**. Among the muralists is Pamela Bliss, who not only painted numerous murals in Wayne County and other Indiana spots, but also created a competition which brought additional art to Wayne County. "Not everyone goes to an art museum," she says. "This is something the common person sees every day. It's larger than life, so it pulls you in."

Two murals offer a striking example conveying the region's ties to the Underground Railroad. In Fountain City, the story unfolds at the **Levi & Catharine Coffin State Historic Site**.

Here is the 1839 Coffin house with its hiding room, cellar well, and wagon with hidden compartment, all used by the Coffins in helping more than 1,000 freedom seekers escape slavery.

Other murals commemorate Richmond's recording heritage with Hoagy Carmichael, Louis Armstrong, Bix Beiderbecke and more.

Another piece of public art is the Madonna of the **Trail** in Glen Miller Park in Richmond. It's along the National Road (U.S. 40), America's first highway. In the 1830s, more than 200 wagons passed through every day, heading west. Some stayed, making Wayne County the most populous county in Indiana for awhile. Families going westward first went through Richmond and then through Centerville, where economic success led to the narrowing of the roads, allowing residents to build additional rooms onto the front of their homes. Archways were erected between the brick rowhouses to give access to the rear of the buildings. Five of the original nine still exist.

In historic Cambridge City, Overbeck Pottery can be found at the **Museum of Overbeck Art Pottery**. Educated in the arts, the Overbeck sisters started

creating their unique pottery in 1911 and continued for more than 40 years. Many of the pieces are small, whimsical figurines. The value of the pottery has increased dramatically in recent decades. The sisters gave a lot of their pottery away.

One piece on display at the museum was

purchased at a garage sale for \$5 and is now worth \$40,000.

Overbeck pieces are also at the **Richmond Art Museum**. The focus of the Richmond Art Museum is on

American art, particularly Hoosier. "In the early 1900s Richmond, Indiana had a group of artists whose interest in fostering art in their community made an authentic contribution to the history of art in America. Richmond became an important center for art, a place

became an important center for art, a place that nourished and inspired artists," says Director Shaun Dingwerth.

More recent galleries
and an outdoor
sculpture exhibit are on
the campuses of Earlham
College and Indiana University
East. Nearby, Bill and Jeanne

Magaw, known as the **Magaws of Boston** (Indiana), have been creating contemporary kinetic sculptures in their country studio since 1970. Many brightly colored pieces have involved water; others are powered by wind. Other shops offer classes and supplies for creating art. **Ply Fiber Arts** focuses on knitting, crocheting, and weaving.

FOLLOW FOOTSTEPS TO FREEDOM



Wayne County's rich Quaker history played an integral role in the efforts of abolitionists. At the Levi & Catharine Coffin House, Grand Central Station of the Underground Railroad, you'll uncover why escaping slavery was complicated and why the Coffins were passionate about assisting freedom seekers.



The hands-on, interactive **Paint the Towne** art studio has classes on bisque pottery, acrylic painting, glass art, and mixed media – sometimes as wine parties. "I wanted a place where people could come to experience art," says owner Maria Haber.

The first high school orchestra in the nation was in Richmond. Today, national and international musical performances are offered at the **Civic Hall Performing Arts Center**, **Earlham College**, and the **Reid Center**.

Blues music is showcased at the **Firehouse BBQ & Blues** on weekends. The revitalized area of Richmond's **Historic Depot District** has become the "in" place to be, encompassing restaurants, a coffee bar and tap


room, an ice cream parlor, bakery, shoppes, and the **Model T Museum**.

Additional early cars that were manufactured in Richmond are at the **Wayne County Historical Museum**.

The museum is a unique repository of local history from early pioneer life to modern times, with items ranging from a Conestoga wagon to a doll house. There's even a mummy, brought from Egypt by museum founder Julia Meek Gaar, who traveled extensively around the world and brought her findings home, where they are exhibited. Another exhibit at the museum pays tribute to American jazz, blues, big band, country (known today as old-time music), and gospel greats who recorded at Richmond's tiny studio, Gennett Recording Studio, from 1917 to 1937. The list of famous musicians who recorded under the Gennett label is a long one, including

the very first recordings made by Louis Armstrong, Charlie Patton, Blind Lemon Jefferson, Hoagy Carmichael – the list goes on. The Gennett Records experience features interactive activities, video, artifacts, historic photos, music, and a reconstruction of the one-room Gennett recording studio.

The Joseph Moore Museum of
Natural History at Earlham College
contains skeletons of a mastodon,
allosaurus, giant beaver (the most
complete fossilized beaver in the world),
interactive stations for youngsters, an
Egyptian mummy, a planetarium, and an
extremely popular exhibit that includes
live reptiles. Wayne County's first fairy
home appeared at the Joseph Moore
Museum in 2012. Now more than 40
fairy sites are available, sometimes in
hidden spots, on the Fairy Trail.



GENNETT RECORDS
WALK OF FAME

During the early 20th century, one small, humble recording studio in Richmond had a major ripple effect on American music history. Despite racial segregation, Gennett was open to recording all kinds of genres and artists. Gennett welcomed legendary musicians like Louis Armstrong, Gene Autry, Duke Ellington, Jelly Roll Morton, and Fletcher Henderson. The Walk of Fame recognizes pioneering musicians who recorded for the company with large, bronze replicas of the Gennett records, each embedded with a beautiful mosaic ceramic tile.




Recreation & Family Fun



WITH TWO WORLD-CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL CENTERS AND A VARIETY OF TRAILS, WAYNE COUNTY'S MANTRA COULD WELL BE "TAKE A HIKE," MEANT IN THE MOST POSITIVE WAY, FOR A PROFUSION OF PHYSICAL, MENTAL AND SPIRITUAL REASONS.

With 466 acres, **Hayes Arboretum** offers hiking trails, ponds, fields, wetlands and an Indian mound. It has 3% of the state's old-growth forest plus acres of reforested land. Having the foresight to guarantee its future by creating a foundation in 1959, four generations of the Hayes family have worked this land, carrying on Stanley Hayes' commitment to not only preserve and protect nature but also share it with the public through recreation and education.



Long before woolly mammoths roamed the frozen plains, long before dinosaurs existed, Indiana was covered by a shallow sea flourishing with life. The fossils found in the area give us some idea of what life was like 445 million years ago. Fossils of snails, coral, trilobites, bivalves, brachiopods, bryozoans, and others can be found among rock formations, along stream banks of the Whitewater Gorge Trail, or any place where nature and time have eroded them from the surrounding rock. Stop by the Welcome Center or the Joseph Moore Museum to grab your Fossil Hunt Passport.

"Native trees and reforestation was his passion and his hobby," says great-grandson Steve Hayes Jr. "He wanted more people to have his love of reforestation." In April 1963, the land was opened to the public; more than 1,000 cars were lined up to get in. Admission was free then and continues to be free.

"The No. 1 thing people like about the arboretum is the hiking trails, Hayes says. "Come run through the woods. Bring your dog." There are 16 miles of trails, mountain bike trails, a 3-mile auto tour, guided hikes that include a meditation

hike, a Native American history hike, children's outdoor playscape, butterfly garden, nature center, and history museum. Here, you can test your mountain biking skills – the arboretum has been voted one of Indiana's best mountain biking venues.

The main entrance is open 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Tuesday-Saturday, but the East Side Trails entrance is open dawn to dusk every day.

The Cope Environmental Center, just west of Richmond, was established in 1992 when educators Jim and Helen Cope transformed their farm into a nature center with botanist, arborist,

Cope Environmental Center is full of opportunities for visitors of all ages to interact with nature.

They encourage people to be active in nature - to touch, smell, even taste the great outdoors to awaken and

discover their sense of wonder. There are three miles of hiking trails through habitats, prairies, and

wetlands, an abundance of wildlife to be seen, and a natural playscape for the little ones to explore. Cope's education building is a "living building" made from mostly local, sustainable, toxin-free and energy-efficient materials. As at Hayes Arboretum, admission to the trails at Cope is free.

The **Cardinal Greenway** is Indiana's longest rail-to-trail covering 62 miles from Richmond to Marion. The Greenway connects to the Whitewater Gorge **Trail**, which adds another 3.5 miles south of the trail. This urban trail passes local geology and history, taking in the Starr-Gennett Logo building and Gennett **Records Walk of Fame** and studio site. FREE bike rentals are available at Cycling and Fitness Warehouse in Richmond.

Middlefork Reservoir is undoubtedly one of Richmond's best-kept secrets. Here, you can rent a kayak, canoe, paddleboat or rowboat to spend some time on the smooth water. Fishing and eagle watching are also popular activities at the reservoir.

Try your hand at **disc golf** or **pickleball**. Putt around Wayne County's golf courses, gather together friends and family for a high-spirited paintball quest or visit historic McBride Stadium to cheer



on the **Richmond Jazz**, a collegiate summer baseball league team.


Visit Indiana's Highest Point, then take in the beauty of Thistlethwaite Falls, where you can also hunt for fossils from 445 million years ago. Brilliant colors are plentiful at the Richmond Rose Garden. You're invited to sit a spell to take in the sweet fragrance and ponder their beauty.

Wayne County has many **family farms** offering a variety of seasonal agricultural outings such as u-pick flower farms, Amish greenhouses, pumpkin patches, fresh produce stands, orchards, and unique animal encounters.

In the fall, pick apples at **Dougherty Orchards**, the oldest family-owned apple orchard in the state. Their petting farm allows you to get up close with a variety of animals, and be sure to visit the 1883 Winery.

The winter months offer plenty of options, from invigorating cross-country skiing to fun-filled snow tubing at **Valley's Edge**. The **Meltdown Winter Ice Festival** takes place the last weekend in January. It's a weekend where professional ice carvers transform over 20,000 pounds of ice into amazing ice sculptures throughout Richmond's city center.



BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER, AFTERNOON BITE, LATE-NIGHT SNACK — THERE'S A PLACE TO FIND IT ALL IN WAYNE COUNTY.

Breakfast begins early at **AJ's Main Street Diner in Richmond**. This retro diner has 14 stools at the counter and five booths, all generally filled each morning with locals and visitors. It's the perfect spot for breakfast or lunch. Try fan favorites like made-to-order omelets, homemade biscuits and gravy, French toast for breakfast or a hand-patty burger, or the daily special for lunch.

Located in the Historic Depot District, **Roscoe's Coffee Bar and Tap Room**roasts their own organic beans to bring you the perfect cup of coffee. On the menu are a nice variety of teas, smoothies, sandwiches, wraps, salads, and pastries, along with flavorful wines and a lineup of specialty craft beers that cannot be found 'on tap' anywhere else around the area.

Helmed by Chef Moises, **Little Sheba's Restaurant** features signature dishes, sandwiches, pizza and home-made desserts. Popular items on the menu include the breaded tenderloin sandwich, Reuben, steak tacos, and sizzling quesadillas, all made with fresh ingredients. Their delicious food and drinks can be enjoyed either on the beautiful patio or in the inviting dining room.

On the next block, where Firehouse No. 1 was built in 1860, there's **Firehouse BBQ** & Blues. Firehouse owner Tom Broyles loved the old building. He'd always been interested in barbecue and appreciates Richmond's rich music history. So in 2012, his passions merged with the opening of Firehouse BBQ & Blues. The restaurant honors its firefighter past with murals, patches from fire stations throughout the country, and even a fireman's pole. Additional murals focus on Richmond's strong music history, and tabletops present quotes from the music

greats. Entrees focus on hickory-smoked meats and sides made fresh daily. On Friday and Saturday nights there's live music.

The classy/casual **Cordial Cork Restaurant** and **Wine Bar** began by offering wines by owner Adam Melton, but diners desired more. So, he started offering an array of fresh fare, and it was a hit. The stuffed salmon is one of the most popular dishes, along with sesame stir-fry and shrimp or chicken carbonara. There's an extensive selection of local and international wines, craft beer, bourbon and signature cocktails. Flights are also available.

Legends Southside Bar & Grill opened in 1858 and is Wayne County's oldest tavern. The pub at South 5th and D streets became the neighborhood gathering spot along the lines of "Cheers." The Legend burger is its No. 1 seller, with the Penguin Tenderloin sandwich coming in at No. 2 and their wings at No. 3.

Located in historic Centerville, **5 Arch Brewery** serves up house brews, Indianamade spirits and wine. They offer scratch pub fare with a great lineup of burgers (made with short-rib meat, ground chuck and steak), pulled pork, pizza, and hand-cut fries cooked in beef tallow. Everything is made in-house, even the buns.

In Cambridge City, **Lumpy's Cafe**'s signature dish is their giant hand-breaded tenderloin sandwich that's crisp on the outside and juicy on the inside. If you're a lover of soups, salads, sandwiches, wraps, and delightful desserts, **King's Café** on Main Street is the place to go.

No. 9 Grill is a popular spot for lunch and dinner and boasts of fresh-cut steaks, juicy burgers, pastas and salads.

Since 1984, the **Old Richmond Inn** has been the heart and soul of fine and casual dining.


Timeless classics, dishes with international influences, and











decadent desserts are created by chef/owner Galo Molina. All entrees are crafted with the finest and freshest ingredients available.

Other Richmond options owned by the Molinas offer different experiences – "always fresh, always Italian" at **Galo's** Italian Grill; the nautically themed atmosphere at Ainsley's Cafe & Harbor Bar, located on Brookville Reservoir; and

5th Street Coffee and Bagels, where all the restaurants' breads are made.

Fountain Acres Amish Market has samples aplenty: cheeses, salads, even items in small sample cups on refrigerated shelves, and made-to-order fresh deli sandwiches. You'll want to take some cashcash because they don't accept credit cards.

In Hagerstown, the place to stop is Abbott's Candies. And the candy to get is caramels, crafted the old-fashioned way: small batches, hand cut, hand wrapped, hand packaged. And while the huge copper cooking pot is stirred continually by a handmade paddle that's been mechanized, its molten treasure is still poured by two workers.

Claim a table at Willie & Reds for a bountiful meal. The incredible smorgasbord full of home-style favorites is what keeps people coming back. Menu dining is also available for those seeking a lighter meal.

In Wayne County, you can also get a taste of ethnic diversity: Thai, Indian, Italian, Japanese, Greek, and Mexican. Gulzar's Indian Cuisine serves all the classic Indian dishes: tikka masala, korma, vindaloo, and more, with lamb, goat, chicken, seafood, or vegetarian. Gulzar's also features biryani dishes, tandoori chicken, and melt-in-yourmouth naan bread fresh out of the oven. Plus, Gulzar's offers a lunch buffet and cozy outdoor seating. Just north of Cambridge City, Café Neo is known for their Greek donuts called loukoumades and their "Greek-style Espresso Coffee."

A midday treat – ice cream, perhaps – is available at **Ullery's Homemade Ice** Cream Parlor featuring 12 tantalizing flavors. Or, treat yourself to some of Wayne County's family-owned bakeries – cream horns, cannoli, donuts, moist and tasty cakes, decorated cookies and cupcakes, and macaroons can be found at our local bakeries.
